

Coronavirus Visitor Information – Updated 18 March 2020

The safety and wellbeing of our guests and staff is our priority and we will take all necessary precautions to ensure their continued welfare. As with many businesses, we are actively monitoring the situation with regards to the outbreak of Covid-19 coronavirus and are reviewing and following the guidelines of Public Health England.

We wish to reassure you that the Pleasure Beach is taking all possible steps to minimise the risk of contagion, including enhanced cleaning regimes throughout the park. We will continue to act quickly should we be required to do so and will take all necessary precautions to protect the welfare of our visitors and staff.

Whilst we are still planning to open the Park to the Public on Saturday 28th March, as with many businesses, we are actively monitoring the Coronavirus situation. At the current moment the guidelines of the Government have not changed regarding theme parks, so we continue to plan for opening on the scheduled date.

If we open our gates to the public as advertised, we ask for everybody's co-operation regarding the health and wellbeing of all those on our site by adhering to the following:

- Please respect peoples' space and distance yourselves as per the government guidelines.
- It is important that if you feel unwell you do not visit our attraction, we would warmly welcome you when you have fully recovered.
- Please wash your hands frequently following the advertised procedure.
- Please prevent the spread of the virus by the following methods of personal hygiene
 - Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
 - Putting used tissues in the bins provided immediately.
 - Using hand Sanitizer
